People often experience anger, frustration and conflict which if not resolved and managed can lead to increased stress and decreased productivity. The anger and conflict program is a practical program that will help people deal with anger and conflict in a positive, energising manner.

It will give you helpful steps to manage anger in yourself and others. It will help you cope with stress and transform the way you manage emotions in yourself and in your work and home environment.

Anger can typically escalate. It deals with the ways people deal with conflict and what factors affect our conflict modes. Notice the symptoms of anger, the causes of anger and strategies to keep anger at bay.

Ebola Outbreak



Ebola is a severe illness where some 90% of infected people die, and which has no vaccine or treatment, and is able to quickly infect many people. Sick people can spread this disease to other through direct contact.

Wash your hands often and with soap. Early symptoms of Ebola include fever, tiredness, headaches and nausea. These symptoms start within two days of contact with an infected person or body.

The public in general is advised not to wash, touch or kiss dead bodies, or come into contact with their body fluids including blood, vomit, faeces or diarrhoea, or urine or to wash hands in the same bucket as other people who have touched bodies killed by Ebola. The public is also informed that Ebola spreads through animals such as monkeys and bats.

The disease has killed 1535 persons in Liberia, Sierra Leone, Guinea and Nigeria since it broke out.

The World Health Organisation has warned the current outbreak could infect up to 20,000 people before it ends.

If you get sick and develop symptoms such as fever, tiredness, headache, nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea, coughing or bleed from the nose or mouth visit the nearest medical centre.

Experts have said that some people are able to survive the disease due to the workings of their immune system. In fact according to research, some people have immune systems that will prevent the disease altogether.

Updates on the Ebola outbreak watch the news, listen to the radio, read the daily newspapers, google and share the information with the employees, and families.
